Parents must sign a form authorizing the issuance of a library card to a child under the age of 13. Your first library card is free of charge. Replacement cards are \$1.00. * Acceptable forms of identification: New York State driver's license with current street address. Applicants are required to provide another form of ID verifying address.]; Valid picture identification card with name, current address, and signature; Dwelling lease; Voter's registration card with current address. Persons not able to furnish the identification noted above may consult with the library director regarding acceptable alternatives. Other residents of New York State who do not live, work, own property, or attend school in the three-county NIOGA service area are eligible for borrowing privileges by applying for an individual library card for a fee of \$40.00; these cards have a 15-item limit and are valid for one year.

Library cards are issued to residents of Niagara, Orleans and Genesee counties or if you work or own property in the town of Newfane. Seasonal renters need to provide a copy of their renter's agreement. Proof of residence is required in the form of a picture ID, plus name and current address. If the current address is not on the picture ID, a piece of mail or a utility bill with name and current address along with picture ID is acceptable. If you are NOT a resident, but work within the Newfane School District, you must provide proof of this, such as a pay stub. Anyone under the age of 16 MUST have completed a Library Card Application (this can also be done at the library), and MUST be signed by a parent if under the age of 13. Your first library card is free of charge. Replacement cards are \$1.00. Other residents of New York State who do not live, work, own property, or attend school in the three-county NIOGA service area are eligible for borrowing privileges by applying for an individual library card for a fee of \$40.00; these cards have a 15-item limit and are valid for one year. A valid picture ID and current address is required.

Anyone who is a resident or property owner in Niagara, Orleans or Genesee County (Nioga Library System) is eligible for a free library card. Special arrangements for short-term borrower's cards may be made for students at Niagara University and selected other non-resident visitors. Inquire at the Circulation Desk. Patrons must have their library card with them to borrow items from the library. The replacement cost for a lost card is \$1.00. Adult Cards (age 13 and over) To apply for a card you must present two forms of identification that establish your identity and residency. Examples: Identity: Photo ID such as a driver's license, government issued ID card, school ID, school lunch card Residency: An item with your current address printed on it, such as a bill or letter sent to the home (dated within the past two months) or a recent report card. Children's Cards (age 5 – 12) Children are eligible for their own cards beginning at age 5. A parent or legal guardian must come into the library with the child and present two forms of identification (see examples above) issued in the adult's name. The child must also be present. Nonresidents: Individuals who do not reside or own property in Niagara, Orleans or Genesee counties may obtain a library card by paying a fee of \$25.00 per year. This card provides for the loan of up to 15 items at one time.

<p>Library Cards Anyone living in Niagara, Orleans or Genesee County (Nioga Library System) is entitled to a free library card. To apply for a card you must present proper identification with your name and street address. Applicants under the age of 18 require a parent's signature. Children are eligible for their own cards at age five. If you live in Erie County you can still apply for a card with proper identification. There is a \$40.00 annual fee. This entitles the cardholder to borrow up to ten items, printed materials only (no audio-video materials).</p>

<p>Non-resident (i.e. individuals residing outside of the NIOGA Library System) are eligible for borrowing privileges at the Library at a charge. Non-residents as described above may obtain a library card for this purpose at a cost of \$40/year. In order to obtain a library card, you must provide one of the following documents: New York State Driver's license with current street address There is one exception to the above non-resident use of the Library: Out of area boaters visiting the area via the Erie Canal System (a P.O. Box is not acceptable as it does not prove residence). Applicants in this case would need to provide another form of ID verifying address. <p>The Library will issue borrowers' cards and the privileges that accompany the cards to the residents of the Town of Porter who have a Youngstown, New York 14174 mailing address. The Library will issue borrowers' cards and the privileges that accompany the cards to the residents of the Town of Porter who have a Youngstown, New York 14174 mailing address. There is no charge for becoming a borrower of the Library. Borrowers' cards are valid for a period of 2 years from the date of registration. The cards may be renewed if the borrower has no outstanding obligations to the Library. New borrowers and those who apply for renewal of their cards must provide identification with current address information at the time of registration. Children of all ages are eligible for a card; a parent must be present at registration. Non-Residents: Visitors staying with a local resident may borrow materials on their host's card with his/her permission. Temporary cards may be issued to seasonal residents of Youngstown, New York if they have a local address and/or phone number. The patron must provide identification with a permanent address. Guest passes are available to non-cardholders who wish to borrow an Internet computer for use in the Youngstown Free Library. Patrons from other NIOGA libraries may borrow materials from the Youngstown Free Library using their NIOGA or local library card. People wishing to obtain a Youngstown Free Library card who do not reside in or own land in the NIOGA Library system may be issued a card for \$40.00 per year.</p>
